Did you know that once 6'000 roman legionaries waited here for their marching orders? Come and see all the bits and pieces they left behind. You will then know how they lived, dressed and ate – and other things too,



There are literally thousands of artefacts from those days on display, including Roman notebooks (tablets!) which tell their own story, love lives included! The centrepiece is a model of the “castrum”, the barracks. This will all be explained to us in a guided tour (probably in German).

The museum itself is worth a mention. It was purpose-built in 1912 by a local architect and subsequently served as a model for a museum in Holland. It is quite a building.

We meet outside the museum in Museumstrasse 1, Brugg at 14.30 h. There is a charge for entry, Fr. 5.—for members, Fr. 7.—for non-members.
